This summer was an exciting one for our Alpine Adventure Camps and Bike Adventure Camps, with significant growth in participation and more kids than ever spending their summer exploring Mount Washington. Our Alpine campers hiked, explored, visited the Marmot Recovery Centre, played and adventured their way around the mountain. Meanwhile, our Bike Adventure campers built confidence and skills on two wheels in the Bike Park and Skills Park while also learning about trail building and what goes into creating the trails they love to ride.

The response from families has been incredible, and the growth of both programs has given us the opportunity to take the next big step. Next summer, we are expanding to eight full weeks of both Alpine and Bike Adventure Camps, expanding our age groups and evolving our mentor program, guiding graduated campers into camp mentors and future instructors! Last winter certainly gave us some challenging conditions, but one of the things we were most proud of was the skill

development we saw across our seasonal programs. With the terrain we had available, our instructors went back to basics, focusing on strong fundamentals, purposeful mileage and making the most of every learning opportunity.

We've also made some exciting changes to make Snow School work even better for families. That means a full day of learning, skiing or snowboarding and fun for the kids — and a little more uninterrupted mountain time for parents!

Making skiing and snowboarding more accessible continues to be an important focus for us. Our Night Discover Ski and Snowboard Group Lessons start from just \$54, creating an affordable way for

new skiers and riders to experience the mountain, learn the basics and discover what makes snow sports so special. And there's something new this winter: Thursday Night Discover Lessons are 40% off! It's another way we're working to reduce barriers and give more people the opportunity to get on snow, develop their skills and become part of our mountain community.

Our Nordic Centre continues to offer accessible and affordable fun for individuals and families! Our cross-country ski and snowshoe trails provide a gateway to Strathcona Park and Raven Lodge is your home base for XC ski lessons, guided snowshoe tours, rentals, tobogganing and enjoying a post adventure treat!

New this winter, Family Fridays are coming to the Nordic Centre, where kids will cross-country ski or snowshoe for free! Fridays from 9am–4pm, families will receive a **free** child day pass, with the purchase of an adult pass!
